Dear All,

Beginning with a happy note, I share with you that in the financial year just concluded, we did well in our Textile business, in keeping with our track record of steady growth and also managed to do well in Graphite segment. I hope that this positive trend would continue with even better results in the current financial year (2014-15).

I wish to reaffirm that this is a good news for the Group considering the overall economic scenario, which was not very favourable as most of the Business sectors including agriculture, mining, real estate, manufacturing and services have seen declining trends. Our GDP rate hit a decade low of 4.5% during the FY 2013-14. In the third quarter of this financial year (Oct-Dec 2013), the Labour Bureau found out that growth in employment generation fell as much as 40% as against the second quarter. This was attributed to contraction of employment provided in the exporting units of the information technology-business process outsourcing (IT-BPO) sector.

It may also be a matter of concern for policy makers that the Asian Development Bank has lowered the growth projection for 2014-15 to 5.5% from its earlier estimate of 5.7%. This however is better than 4.9% growth estimate for 2013-14. Significantly, the ADB noted that the economy was still operating below potential, as it remained constrained by slow industrial growth, contracting manufacturing output, weak investment, and a reduction in private consumption.

In this backdrop, I take solace in the fact that our Group has done reasonably well. This has been because of our watchful and focused approach towards business. We planned and managed things well with prudence and caution. You have all been an integral part of this strategy and its execution. Your zealously guarding our well-entrenched value system and complete alignment to the organizational thinking to deal with the challenges and contributing your best has helped the Group retain its position of pride in the business sphere.

At the moment, the atmosphere is abuzz with political activities and soon we shall have a new government in place. We anticipate the new government will bring in an era of further reforms and progress for the industry and economy. I also hope we ride back on the path of prosperity and global competition that began with country's economic liberalization in the 1990s.

Hopefully, 2014 could script a new chapter in India to which we all are looking forward to be part of.


Be it whatever, I am confident that your passion and commitment to the organisational objectives would keep the spirits of achievement going.

#### Wind Power Project commissisoned at Kolhapur: BEL



Bhilwara Energy Limited (BEL) had planned for development of a 20 MW Wind Power Project (WPP) at Bhendwade Site, Kolhapur, Maharashtra, in FY 2013-14. The 14 MW of the planned 20 MW have been commissioned as on 31st March, 2014 by using 7 Wind Turbine Generators (WTGs) of 2.0 MW each. The project was executed by Inox Wind Limited on turnkey basis. 100% of the Power shall be sold to MSEDCL under a long term PPA for 13 years effective from COD. The project is also eligible to receive Generation Based Incentive under its new scheme. The project is financed by IREDA, New Delhi.

#### Highest sale of RSWM yarns in March'14

The Financial Year 2013-14 has just ended with a good note on the performance of Yarn Business, particularly in the month of March, 2014 where RSWM achieved the highest sales so far i.e. 6,249 tonnes in Export and 6,083 tonnes in Domestic. It is also a matter of great pleasure and pride that the export of 6,249 tonnes is ever highest export in Yarn Business and in the month of March export has exceeded domestic sales also. In export, there is a growth of 22% over last year and in domestic the growth is 1.82% in 2013-14.



#### **Annual Day: Rishabhdev**





Shri Choudhury felt very pleased with the Ringas Unit team as he shared his views about the organisational growth.




#### **Body Building Championship 2014: Bhilwara**


#### Republic Day: Kharigram


#### **Republic Day Celebration: Ringas**


#### Republic Day: LNJ Denim


