Shri A. K. Mehta, Vice President and senior staff gave away him memento and expressed best wishes for his retired life.





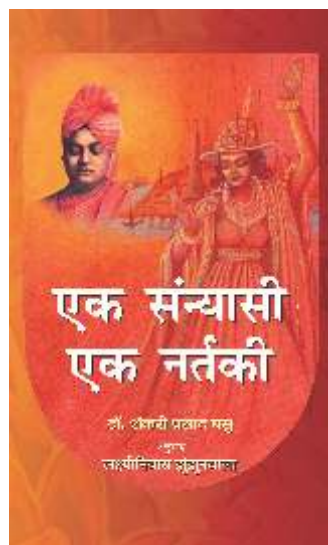
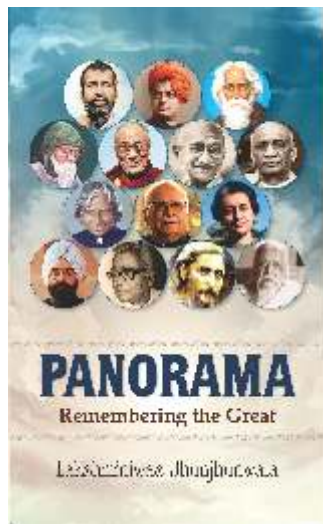
## Books of Shri L. N. Jhunjhunwala Released

Shri L. N. Jhunjhunwala, the Founder & Chairman-Emeritus, LNJ Bhilwara Group, has put forward his life experiences, secrets, love, struggle and success with his two books namely; '**Panorama - Remembering the Great**' and '**Ek Sanyasi Ek Nartaki**' published recently under the publisher, Ocean Books Pvt. Ltd. New Delhi.

**Panorama** takes readers to a roller coaster ride through the last seven decades of his life and experiences. It paints a vivid picture of what India gained and what it missed out. In **Panorama**, one meets a young person in his early days struggling with economic constraints of his family however determined to succeed above all odds. From individual to creating an industry, from innovator to illustrious achievers, from preacher to politician, from bureaucracy to business, **Panorama** has it all.

**Ek Sanyasi Ek Nartaki** was written by Dr. Shankari Prasad Basu in bangla language and translated into Hindi by Shri Jhunjhunwala, is a real life story based on the relationship between Swami Vivekananda and Emma Calve. Emma Calve was the most famous French female opera singer of the Belle Époque. She had an international career and sang regularly at the Metropolitan Opera House, New York, and the Royal Opera House, London. This is a story on how Swami Vivekanand influenced Emma's life. Inspite of facing many struggles in life, she achieved enormous success in the field of dance and drama. At the peak of her career, she met with a tragic incident. She lost her only daughter while she was away performing at the theatre. She was so depressed that she attempted suicide. During this phase of her life she got an opportunity to meet Swami Vivekananda who changed her life tremendously. Swami ji's optimistic view inspired her to go back to her normal life and start her career from where she left.

Earlier, Shri Jhunjhunwala also presented his books **Vishwa Dharm Sammelan 1893** in Hindi and translated in English - **The World Parliament of Religions, 1893** translated in English on the subject which was held in Chicago.



## Barhaths - The Forgotten Martyr Family of Bhilwara

Bhilwara is proud to have produced a great martyr family of Barhaths. Three family members - eldest being Shri Kesari Singh, his younger brother, Zorawar Singh, son, Pratap Singh sacrificed their life for the country.

Pratap and Zorawar were entrusted by Rashbehari Bose with the job of throwing Bomb on Lord Hardinge when he was entering Delhi in a

big royal procession. Lord Hardinge was injured. Zorawar Singh fled and remained underground all his life. Pratap was caught and kept in Bareilly Jail. The Director of the CID, Sir Charles Cleaveland, came to Bareilly to meet Pratap Singh.

Sir, Charles Cleaveland has written about Pratap Singh in his memoirs: "I have not seen in my entire life a better man and hero like Pratap. We gave him all kinds of unbearable tortures. But my salutation to this young man. He did not



budge an inch. Extra-ordinary patriot who stood firm inspite of the inhuman tortures. All our attempts failed. We were defeated. Finally, it was he who won"

The statue of all the three martyrs has been installed at a park in Bhilwara city by the Group to commemorate their memories. On the occasion, Shri L. N. Jhunjhunwala paid the tribute by garlanding on the statue.
