
Free Health Check-up Camp (ESIC)

Eco Brick Project



The Eco Project led by Ishan Rathod is actively involved in collecting eco-bricks. An eco-brick is a plastic bottle tightly filled with used plastic, repurposing it into a robust building material that effectively sequesters

waste. These eco-bricks are utilized to create stools, sofas and a variety of other structures, significantly contributing to sustainable initiatives and promoting environmental responsibility within the community.

Vermicomposting Project

This project promotes sustainable agriculture through organic practices. Sparked by a family conversation about reusing dry neem leaves, a terrace garden was created using compost from household and temple waste. Over 8–12 months, crops like brinjal, pumpkin, and coriander were grown successfully without chemicals. Encouraged by the

results, the family set up six vermicompost pits using cow dung, agri-waste, and earthworms from Krishi Vigyan Kendra, improving soil fertility and crop yields.



Jaivika Kushwah, an SDG Club member, expanded the initiative by establishing a vermicomposting unit on her land. She now supplies organic manure to over 45 local customers, promoting terrace gardening and organic farming in her community. Her efforts are raising awareness and encouraging healthier, sustainable cultivation practices.

Festive gatherings were held at multiple locations, including RSWM Mandapam, RSWM-Ringas, and the HO in Noida, where employees came together to












honour the traditional harvest festival. Lohri celebrations at RSWM were marked by a vibrant spirit of unity, cultural appreciation, and community service.



Equal Breathing:

- · Inhale for a count of four.
- · Exhale for a count of four.
- This balanced pattern calms both body and mind.

Pursed-Lip Breathing:

- Inhale deeply through your nose for two seconds, filling your lungs.
- Pucker your lips as if to whistle.
- Exhale slowly through pursed lips, taking twice as long as your inhalation.
- Repeat to gain better breath control and increase oxygen intake.

Box Breathing:

- Hold your breath for a count of four.
- Exhale for a count of four.
- Pause for a count of four before the next inhalation.
- This method is effective for stress and anxiety reduction.

bolstering lung health, Beyond these exercises offer a holistic array of benefits extending to various aspects of well-being. Engaging in them regularly can significantly reduce stress and worry, fostering a calmer mental state. They also contribute to better blood pressure control, supporting cardiovascular health. Furthermore, these exercises are known to enhance sleep quality, leading to more restorative rest, and can notably improve focus and concentration, boosting cognitive function. Finally. consistent participation can lead to increased energy levels, invigorating daily life.
